## **§1 History**

This Policy was adopted at the Fall Guild Meeting 1 2015, edited at the Fall Guild Meeting 1 2017, Spring Guild Meeting 2018, Fall Guild Meeting 1 2018, Spring Guild Meeting 2020 and last edited at the Fall Guild Meeting 1 2021.

## **§2 Purpose**

The policy was instituted on November the 16<sup>th</sup> 2015 at the first Fall Guild Meeting of the Guild of Chemical Engineering and Biotechnology. The purpose of the policy is to clarify who is entitled to a subsidized price and at which events. The policy is not intended to limit who receives a subsidized price to only those defined in this policy.

## **§3 Subsidized Price**

### **§3:1 Definition**

Being entitled to a subsidized price means that you are entitled to half the price of the ticket. This is provided that the price of the subsidized ticket does not fall below 1.25 times the purchase price for any alcohol included in the ticket. Then you are entitled to 1.25 times the purchase price for the alcohol included in the ticket. This is because we are not allowed to discount alcohol according to the Alcohol Act.

### **§3:2 The Student Board**

The Student Board does not have the right to representation at the K-Guild events, with the exception of the President who has commitments during the Annual Calibration Ball that require him/her to attend and is thus entitled to receive a subsidized price. This is taken out of the Board's budget. The Board Member in Charge of Education has commitments at Nollegasquen, which means that he/she is entitled to a subsidized price. This is taken out of the Student Board's budget.

### **§3:3 The Introduction Committee**

The Introduction Committee is entitled to a subsidized price on FlyING as the Introduction Coordinators is responsible during events and the event takes place in another location, which means transport costs. The Introduction Committee is entitled to a subsidized price on Nollegasquen, This is taken out of the Introduction Committee's budget.

### **§3:4 The Festivities Committee**

Members of the Festivities Committee who are active in the work with the Annual Calibration Ball are entitled to a subsidized price. This is because Festivities Committee works before and after the event and has a certain responsibility during the ball. This is taken out of the Festivities Committee's budget. The Toastmaster is, at the events he/she works on, entitled to a subsidized price. This is taken out of the budget of the committee organizing the event.

### **§3:5 The Honours Committee**

The Annual Calibration Ball traditionally takes place at a secret location and the Honours Committee has commitments during the evening, which means that the Honours Committee is entitled to a subsidized price. This is taken out of the Honours Committee's budget.

### **§3:6 The Cyber Committee**

If the Photographer is included in the table placement when he works at an event, he is entitled to a subsidized price. If the Photographer attends only to photograph, he/she goes for free. This is taken out of the budget of the committee organizing the event.

### **§3:7 The Student Council of B&K**

As the Head of the Student Council has assignments during the Nollegasquen, he/she is entitled to a subsidized price corresponding to half the price of the ticket, as long as the price of the subsidized ticket does not fall below 1.25 times the purchase price of any alcohol included in the ticket. In that case, the Head of the Student Council is entitled to a subsidized price corresponding to 1.25 times the purchase price of any alcohol included in the ticket. This is taken out of the budget for SrBK.

### **§3:8 The Career Fair Committee**

The Career Fair Committee is entitled to a subsidized price for the KULA-dinner party. This is taken out of the Career Fair Committee's budget.

### **§3:9 The Alumni Committee**

The Alumni Committee is entitled to a subsidized price for the Homecoming-dinner party. This is taken out of the Alumni Committee's budget.
